In addition, be sure to notice all the cool berries on display throughout the gardens. Wondering where to look? Follow the sounds of the birds grabbing goodies to eat! The Golden Raindrops Crabapple is always a stunner with little golden apples dangling for a bird feast. Near the entrance is a nice clump of Beautyberry sporting shiny purple fruits this time of year. In the Native Plant Walk there are too many cool berries to even list - Arums, Wax Myrtle, Huckleberries, Bunchberry, and so much more. Enjoy the season and pause to appreciate and respect the wonderful cycle of nature and all the autumn season gives to us and the wildlife around us. Fall is truly amazing!

At the Arboretum in this wonderful month of September we have an outstanding class for you to attend.
